



A Safety Net for Our Children

The Greater New Bedford Community Health Center has cared for the most vulnerable of New Bedford's children since 1981. The Health Center serves over 23,000 low and moderate income individuals in the city of New Bedford, as well as 5,000 families that participate in our on-site WIC program.

The means in the last year alone, over 25% of the New Bedford's population received care at the Health Center -- and we know the demand for our services continues to grow. This is especially true within our Pediatric Department. Currently, there is a three-week waiting period for a new pediatric patients.

A Need to Grow

The Health Center's Maternal Child Health program works collaboratively with the Pediatrics staff and WIC department to provand effective outreach, early intervention, and case management to reduce low birth weight and infant mortality.

In order to accommodate this high demand, the Health Center must also grow. This is where we need your help.
